*Summary of Change:*

- Base (or 1st zone) rates for all fare categories decrease \$0.05.
- Zone increment rates for all fare categories increase \$0.05.

#### Summary of Change:

- Base Zone rate decreases \$0.10
- Zone increment rate increases \$0.20
- Depending on trip length, paratransit fares are up to 9% less than the maximum fare permitted by the ADA (twice regular/adult fixed-route fare).
